



# Team organization: teaching Systems 4-4-2, 4-2-3-1 and 4-3-3

## DESCRIPTION

This seminar looks specifically at methods for teaching the tactical and strategic principles basic to the organization of a soccer team.

The theoretical and practical lessons making up the seminar give participants a deeper look at those particulars that support good group organization and the various ways of getting this across to the players.

The seminar will be going fully into themes connected with teaching the principles and possible developments of the phase of possession as well as the phase of non-possession. The most common attacking developments of the 4-4-2, 4-2-3-1 and 4-3-3 playing systems will be presented and dealt with in detail. As well as this we will be marking out ways of allowing the single player and the team to make choices in reaction to the tactical context of the match.

Our analysis will include an in-depth look at the solutions used by some of the most representative teams on the continental scene (Arsenal, Barcelona, Manchester United, Roma, Fiorentina, etc.)

Space will also be dedicated to the prerequisites underlying and supporting a winning project. This is what allows the coach to get his working group really involved in an effective way.

The seminar takes place over a two-day period and includes theoretical lessons in the Multimedia Hall of the Football Museum as well as work sessions on the fields in the Technical Centre of Coverciano. The overall length of the seminar is 15 hours. It integrates perfectly with another taking place on 12 and 13 July 2008, the theme of which will be **"Preseason preparations: workloads and programmes for training in fitness, principles and pathways towards training in technique and tactics"**.



## PROGRAMME

The aim is to give the coach instruction in not only the basic but also more advanced and well-developed principles for shaping up his team in as clear a way as possible and with a real tactical identity. The programme includes an accurate analysis of the subjects listed below and the lessons will be given indoors with the help of modern multimedia presentations, as well as outdoors, where the participants will take part in technical and tactical exercises.

The basis for a winning project;

- Principles, methods and rules of behaviour for the right development of the attacking phase;
- Moves, principles and methods for making the best of individual and group behaviour during the defence phase;
- Movements, game plans and flows of play in the 4-3-3;
- Movements, game plans and flows of play in the 4-4-2;
- Movements, game plans and flows of play in the 4-2-3-1;
- Teaching methods and technical tactical exercises on the field.

## LOCATION

The seminar will be held in the famous, highly operational Multimedia Hall of the Football Museum and on the fields of the Technical Centre in Coverciano, Saturday 12/07 and Sunday 13/07.

The participants will be staying in the four star Hotel and Restaurant inside the Technical Centre of Coverciano, where the Italian international team prepares matches and competitions.

The hotel in Coverciano offers double rooms which have recently been redecorated in preparation for welcoming the Italian team before the last World Cup. The rooms are styled for intimacy and cordiality with luxury furnishings, and they all contain bathrooms of the first order and electronic locks. Sleeping accommodation is for a total of 100 people.

All rooms are en suite, with shower, hair dryer, satellite TV with free viewing of SKY channels, direct phone, mini bar, air conditioning and central heating.

The Museum is situated inside the Federation's Technical Centre in Coverciano. There is also, however, an independent entrance at Viale Aldo Palazzeschi, No. 20 (a continuation of Viale Verga).

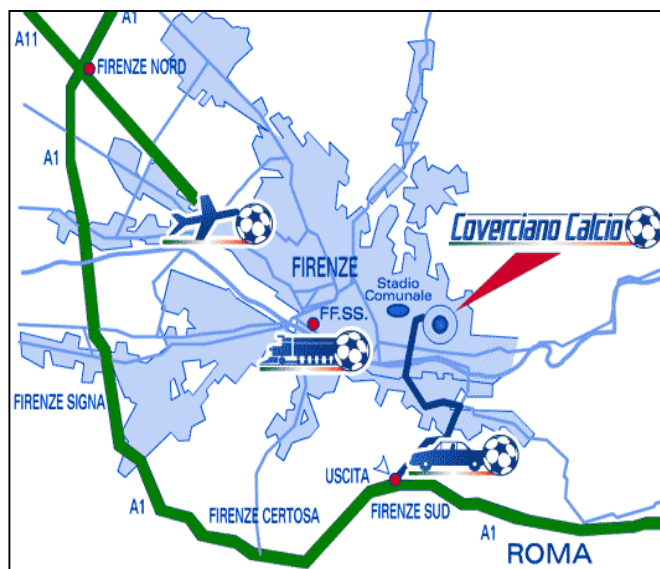
**BY CAR:** going either south or north along the A1 motorway, exit at the toll gate Firenze Sud and follow indications for the Centro Tecnico Federale (CTF), Museo del Calcio (about 4 km. from the motorway exit).

**BY TRAIN:** from the station of Firenze Santa Maria Novella the museum can be reached by taxi (about 20 minutes) or by bus (Line 17 going towards Campo di Marte), in which case you get off at the second last stop before the ride finishes in Viale Verga.

**BY PLANE:** from Amerigo Vespucci Airport the Technical Centre can be reached by taxi (30 mins) or by taking Line 23 bus, then changing to Line 10 or 17.



The Technical Centre of Coverciano has a limited number of places for participants on full board in double rooms (100 beds overall).
